WHEREAS, in many instances parties participating in the electronic filing of court documents are desirous of having the convenience fees, that being four percent, taxed as costs, and:


WHEREAS, the Judges of the District Court of Madison County, Alabama, seek now to establish an expedient and uniform method of allowing such charges to be assessed as court costs,
