Re: Important Notice of Unclaimed Court Funds

Each year, unclaimed funds are held by the Circuit Clerk's Office for an owner that has either failed to claim the funds or cannot be located. It is the policy of the Circuit Clerk's Office of Madison County to disburse monies received in an expedient manner. However, there can be considerable time between the disposition of a case and the actual collection of these funds. When a recipient cannot be located, the funds are returned by the postal service. Periodically, we review cases with funds being held to determine the cause for delay in disbursing the monies. By law, any monies that have been held with no action for five years are classified as unclaimed. These unclaimed monies are then paid over to the Madison County Commission. It is the goal of this office to make a diligent effort to pay these funds to the appropriate recipient. The list below contains the name of individuals or businesses that are due monies. If you or someone you know is listed, contact the Madison County Circuit Clerk's Office at (256) 532-3384. Please have the case number that appears beside your name readily available.
